CAMPOREE FOR DAY VISITORS : ESSENTIAL INFORMATION

Arrival Time

Arrive on **Saturday** through West Entrance (the regular Peaceful Valley entrance for Dobbins). Check in starts at 7 a.m. Activities start at 9 a.m.

Be prepared for delays in Elbert

There is a bike race in Elbert on Saturday morning with a 9 a.m. start time. The bike race will be using Elbert Road for part of the course, so please plan your arrival between 7 a.m. and 8:30 a.m. Please remember to share the road!

Parking Placards (Required)

Parking placards are REQUIRED for entry. Your registration contact should have received this via email. Check your "Junk Email" or "Spam" folder if you haven't seen it. Please print it (preferably in color) and put it on your dash. EVERY vehicle must have a placard, so print them for every driver/vehicle from your unit.

Med Forms (Required)

All participants need the <u>BSA part A & B med forms</u> (all 3 pages) plus a copy of the insurance card. You cannot simply show us your med form binder – you must GIVE US copies for every youth and adult. Med forms will not be returned, so don't bring your originals.

Meals

We are now asking day visitors to pack and bring a sack lunch to eat on site. Due to unforeseen issues our Taste of PV food vendors have had to withdraw from Camporee, so there will not be any options to purchase meals. We apologize for this last minute change.

OTHER NOTES

Weather

Be Prepared: we'll have autumn-like weather. It will be cool at night and sunny during the day. Bring jackets AND sunscreen! Each scout should have their Cub Scout 6 essentials in their daypack. Make sure every person is carrying (and drinking) water all day long.

Wristbands

All participants will receive wristbands upon arrival. All participants must wear these all weekend.

The Event Schedule is in the Leader's Guide

The camporee schedule is attached to the leader's guide as Appendix "A" (pages 29-30). It has been recently updated so your printed version may be out of date. Please read and review before you arrive. <u>Download the leader guide here</u>. You may not want to print all 62 pages of the leader's guide, but you might want to print the schedule.

Camporee District Pins

We were overwhelmed with units that registered at the last minute. Because of this, we will be limiting district pins to one-per-person for adults (sorry). Youth will still receive two pins each.

Camporee Pin Pre-order Pickup

For the scouts and scouters who ordered & paid for additional Camporee Pins in advance, these will be available for pickup on Friday night at your District Headquarters and Saturday during the day at the Dobbins HQ. They must be picked up by the adult or youth who ordered them.

Order of the Arrow Food Drive

OA is holding a food drive at the Camporee. Please bring an item of canned food to donate. These items will be collected at each District HQ on the mesa Friday night.
