



NRA Basic Pistol Instructor Course

The course goal is to develop NRA Certified Basic Pistol Instructors who possess the knowledge, skills, and attitude necessary to conduct the NRA Basic Pistol Shooting Course.

Current NRA Basic Instructor Training (BIT) is a prerequisite. You must have successfully completed BIT within 2 years of the date of this course to be eligible to register.

Per revision of the NRA Basic Pistol Instructor Course by NRA in June of 2017, candidates must complete the NRA Basics of Pistol Shooting Student Course *prior to attending* an NRA Basic Pistol Instructor Course. This will be accomplished on the weekend listed below. Since NRA no longer makes printed lesson plans available, candidates must download/print all course materials and bring them to the course. Detailed instructions to accomplish this will be provided in early August 2018.

No credit will be issued if a candidate drops out less than 2 weeks before the course. All candidates **must** pass the Pre-Qualification Assessment (see item 1a below).

When: Friday, August 24, 2018, 6:00 pm–Aug 26 6:00 pm (Arrive at least 20 minutes early!)

Cost : \$200

Bring: 3-ring binder, pen, pencil (for the test), note paper, eye and ear protection, adequate clothing for the outdoor session. Candidates can provide own handgun and at least 100 rounds of ammunition per candidate, limited to .22 rimfire though 9mm (no magnum, +P, or +P+).

Meals: Bring you own lunch, snacks, and beverages for each day. Evening meal is provided.
