Who Can Apply – High school students with an expected graduation date during the 2010-2011 academic school year
and a registered youth member of the Denver Area Council, Boy Scouts of America.

Role of the Denver Area Council, Boy Scouts of America - The Denver Area Council, Boy Scouts of America is considered a referral agency by the Daniels Fund. This Referral Agency Screening Form is required before an applicant can officially apply for the Daniels Scholarship. Once the screening process is completed, interested applicants will be notified of their status. Individuals who advance in the process, will receive directions on how to complete an online application for the Daniels Scholarship.

Interested applicants need to meet all of the following requirements in order to be considered eligible for a nomination from the Denver Area Council, Boy Scouts of America.

1. Currently have a cumulative Grade Point Average of 2.0.
2. Be a current high school student with an expected graduation during the 2010-2011 school year.
from any high school in Colorado, New Mexico, Utah, or Wyoming.
3. Be a current resident of Colorado, New Mexico, Utah, or Wyoming.
4. At the time of application, be a U.S. citizen, a permanent resident of the United States, or have
refugee or asylum status in the United States.
5. Demonstrate Financial Need (**See Daniels Scholarship Brochure.**)
6. Take the ACT by June 12, 2010 and achieve an exam composite score of 17 or higher, or take the SAT
by June 5, 2010 and achieve a combined math and critical reading score of 830 or higher.
7. Satisfactory completion of the Denver Area Council's Referral Agency Screening Form.
