

## ***DAC Distinguished SCOUTER Award***

1. Earn the **TRAINING AWARD** for your Unit Responsibilities

**(ie. Cub Scouts, Boy Scouts, Varsity, Venturing, Sea Scouts)**

2. In addition to earning the Training Award:

- -Recruit and Assist 2 currently registered but un-trained Scouters in earning the “Trained” patch for their specific position.
- -Mentor 2 new non-registered Adults by registering them as Adult Scouters and assisting them through the process of becoming “Trained” for their registered position
- -In addition to the trainings needed to earn your Training Award, attend 4 additional supplemental or advanced training events at the council, area, region or national level (University of Scouting, Trainers EDGE, Wood Badge, etc.)
- Attend at least 8 Roundtables over the course of 12 months

## ***DAC Distinguished UNIT Award***

1. At least 10% of the Unit's registered Scouters are DAC Distinguished Scouter or a minimum one Leader (if a Unit has less than 10 leaders)
2. The Unit has a system in place to train its Leaders and a volunteer overseeing the Training.
3. The Unit Leader and Committee Chair have completed the training necessary to wear their "Trained" Patch
3. The Unit has achieved at least 4 of the following
  - -At least 1 Leader has completed Trainer's EDGE.
  - -80% of a Unit's Direct Contact Leaders\* have completed the Training necessary to wear the "Trained" emblem for their registered position.
  - -At least 2 registered Leaders have completed Wood Badge.
  - -The Unit has earned the Gold Journey to Excellence designation at least 2 of the last 3 years.
  - -10% or at least one Scout has attended Bighorn, NYLT, Day Camp, or Webelos Weekend.

- **1 Adult and 1 Youth Camper Scholarship to either your Unit or a Unit of your choice or an equivalent amount applied to use of Colorado Adventure Point**
