TOURNAMENT INFORMATION

The Sanctuary Golf Course is the brainchild of RE/MAX International Co-Founder Dave Liniger. Located in Sedalia, just south of Denver it is nestled in the foothills of the Rockies and boasts a beautifully preserved ecosystem as well as an 18-hole, private course. It serves as a refuge for wildlife, native plants, and also golfers looking for a peaceful game of golf.

Sanctuary was conceived as a golf experience that would gracefully balance exclusivity with accessibility. With its reputation as one of the most exclusive courses in the country it has a commitment to preserving the natural terrain and wildlife that abound. That is why the Sanctuary limits the golf course to only 9,000 rounds per year and it is by invite only. Linking tournaments and other events to the support of charitable organizations devoted to the arts, children, health care, and crisis management.

The exclusivity is understandable though since the golf course offers not only beautiful views but also a challenging and fun game of golf. The course designed by famed architect Jim Engh, features felt-like greens that are large, undulating and play fast. Tree-lined fairways and strategically placed bunkers, water and green-side features present some enticing challenges for golfers. The Sanctuary's signature hole is the first, which is a lengthy par-5 with a 250-foot drop off the tee.

Surrounded by nearly 13,000 acres of dedicated open space, the Sanctuary offers a feeling of complete seclusion. With its jaw-dropping scenery, it is a golfer's dream!

CLUB DRESS CODE POLICY

The Sanctuary requires all players to comply with its dress code standards. Participants who are not properly attired will not be allowed to play.

- Men - Shirts are to have sleeves and collars (no tank tops or t-shirts)
- Women - Halter tops and tank tops are not permitted (a halter top is defined as a shirt that exposes any midriff areas. A tank top is defined as having a shoulder strap less than 3" wide)
- Shorts /Bottoms described as "cut-offs" are not permitted. Shorts must be mid-thigh length or longer
- No jeans or denim clothing
- Gymnasium attire is not permitted
