### A Combination of Palms

You may wear only the proper combination of Palms for the number of merit badges you earn beyond Eagle. The Bronze Palm represents 5 merit badges; Gold, 10; and Silver, 15. For example, if you earn 10 merit badges and two Palms, you would wear *only* the Gold Palm. If you earn 20 merit badges and four Palms, you would wear a Silver and a Bronze Palm.
