What:

Scouts can go to camp, even if their troop is not attending camp. Scouts can go to camp as individuals because for one reason or another they cannot attend with their troop, or because they wish to have an additional week of camp.

These Scouts become members of the ***Super Troop*** under trained adult leadership provided by the camp. The Denver Area Council will provide 2 paid leaders for this program as Scoutmaster and Assistant Scoutmaster. They bring only their personal clothing and equipment, plus their desire to work and cooperate with other members of the ***Super Troop***.

A ***Super Troop*** member may participate fully in the camp programs at Camp Cris Dobbins. He can work on rank advancement, earn merit badges, use the lake, rifle ranges and all other activities. No Scout should miss camp just because he can't attend with his troop.

Where:

CAMP CRIS DOBBINS on the Peaceful Valley Scout Ranch.

Who:

All registered Boy Scouts. Each session is limited to 20 Scouts, and no more than 4 Scouts per troop. Note: This is not a substitute for troop camping, but instead is provided for those Scouts who cannot attend summer camp with their troop or team, and/or who wish to attend additional weeks at summer camp.

Why:

This is a great opportunity for Scouts in the Denver Area Council to work on rank advancement and participate in all the other great activities Camp Cris Dobbins has to offer. Besides, it is a great place to have a whole lot of fun in a safe, Scouting environment.

How:

You supply the Scouts and get him to camp, and the camp will supply the experienced adult leadership. Complete the registration form and return it to the Council Service Center with a \$30.00 non-refundable deposit. Once registered, each Scout will later receive additional information, medical forms, etc.

Week #5 – July 4 - 10
Week #6 – July 11 - 17
Week #7 – July 18 - 24

Cost:

The fee for **Super Troop** participants will be \$250. A non-refundable deposit of \$30.00 is required to reserve your spot. This deposit can be transferred to another week, or to other participants. **Full payment is due no later than three weeks prior to the arrival date.** For Scouts returning to camp for additional week, payments can be made at the Council Office.
