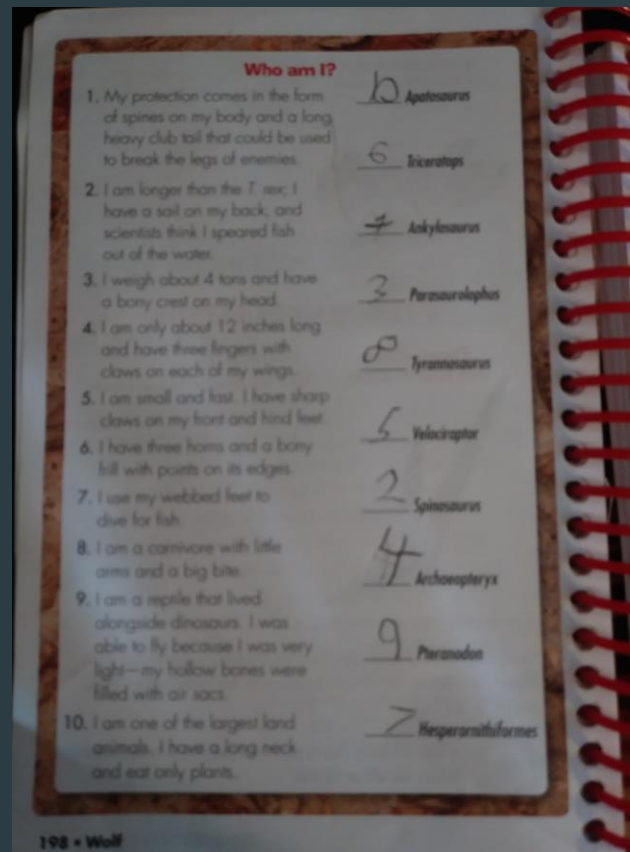


Requirement 1: Play a Game Completed 04/22/20
