

Please use this Equipment Checklist for packing essentials

Please note that the following items are **mandatory** for this camping season and may not be shared between campers.

- Masks** / cloth face coverings- **one per day (7)**. Please arrive for check-in wearing your mask. Masks will be worn when appropriate social distancing guidelines are not possible.
- Sunscreen**: please bring enough for the whole week. Cannot be provided by camp staff and may not be shared.
- Small hand sanitizer**
- Lip Balm, bug spray** highly recommended. Personal items cannot be provided at camp this season.

Each Scout is responsible for bringing **ALL** of the following items:

- o **Full class A Uniform**- leaders model the correct uniform
 - o Official scout pants/shorts- 2 pair recommended, Class A Scout shirt with insignia, belt and socks.
- o Above the ankle, high top hiking boots mandatory. Water proof highly recommended.
- o **Personal tent** (one scout per tent) and ground cloth- please be sure the scout has experience with set up and it is in good working condition. There is no extra gear available. No cots or hammocks please.
- o **Portable camp chair**: seating options are limited in camp and we would like scouts to be comfortable during instruction. Please put name on chair.
- o **Sleeping pad and bag, pillow**. Summer temperatures at altitude can be cold. Plan accordingly with warm gear.
- o **Large backpack**. Scout will be carrying all their gear to the campsites.
- o **Day pack for 10 essentials**. Do not bring fire starting material or trail food/snacks. Scouts will carry their Scout Basic Essentials at all times.
- o **Compass: required item for an activity during camp**
- o **Smaller bag**, labeled with scout name, smellables may be stored away from campsites. Smellables include all types of toiletries, including sunscreen and hand sanitizer. No food please.
- o 1 large **CLEAR water bottle**. NO Camelbacks or metal bottles please.
- o Good **flashlight** / headlamp and extra batteries. Both recommended.
- o Regular **watch with alarm** – No cell phone use- limited charging areas.
- o **Personal clothing** items and toiletries including shower items, towel and shower shoes. Showers are mandatory.
 - o (underwear, sleeping clothes, toothbrush, toothpaste, soap, shampoo, bath towel, washcloth, deodorant- A Scout is Clean. Please be respectful of your campmates and practice good personal hygiene)
 - o 1 pair of Jeans, t-shirt, and work gloves for service project.
- o **Cold weather gear**, coat, hat, gloves, sweatshirt. Can get cool if weather is wet.
- o **Waterproof rain gear**- both jacket and pants recommended. Activities are outside, rain or shine!

Camp provides the following:

One NYLT Hat, 2 activity uniform t-shirts, songbook, and participant handbook. These are considered part of the NYLT uniform and are to be worn at all times.

- o Please do not bring: neckerchief/ slide, sashes, sheath knives, pets, electronics including iPods or electronic games, any tobacco or alcohol products or any kind of food.
