- Ensure climbing equipment is set up correctly.
- Instruct campers on how to climb on various surfaces such as natural and man-made rocks.
- Maintain paperwork and ensure completeness and submit on time.
- Participate in camp-wide activities.
- Assist in the set up and take down of all camp facilities.
- Other duties as assigned.
