Job Summary

The Media Manager will be responsible for taking photographs and videos of campers, staff and activities at each of the ranch's camps and programs. The goal is to collect photos and videos that show campers having a great time at camp that is full of adventure. This position will also be a member of the social media team and is responsible for posting frequent updates (daily) to the ranch's social media platforms. Ultimately the goal is to promote and market a great camp experience to help boost registrations for the current and future summers.

Job Description

ROLE AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Attend camp activities such as classes, campfires, activities, games and other events to take pictures and/or videos at. Goals of the photos and videos are: Showing campers enjoying themselves and having a great time at summer camp.
- Coordinate with other staff members on when and where to be to take photos and videos of activities.
- Take a variety of photos and videos of everything that happens on the ranch. This includes but not limited to: flag ceremonies, meals, classes (learning and doing), hard work, landscape/nature, adventures, weather, training, and most importantly campers having fun.
- Post daily updates to the ranch's social media channels with photos and or videos.
- Post photos and videos from the week on the ranch's social media channels.
- Work with the ranch's social media team to manage the pages.
- Work with the Council's marketing team to gather photos and videos that meet the goals and needs of the marketing team. Produce staged or real photos and videos to help meet this goal.
- This position may teach merit badge classes such as photography and movie making.
- Participate in camp-wide activities.
- Assist in the set up and take down of all camp facilities.
- Submit a "closing report" at the end of the season which includes inventories, daily duties and suggestions for improvement the following year.
- Other duties as assigned by Ranch and Council Leadership.
